GLAAACC COLLEGE PREP

SCHOLAR ORIENTATION

The GLAAACC Education Fund & Foundation hosts a college prep course which provides youth from disadvantaged backgrounds with the academic support, financial assistance, and leadership training to become college graduates. This course is unique in that it leverages board members from companies such as Southern California Edison, SoCal Gas, Microsoft, and JP Morgan Chase, to help students who have demonstrated strong academic potential and a commitment to success, but who have knowledge or opportunity gaps in reaching their potential.



FINANCIAL LITERACY

Financial literacy is important because it allows a student to understand and maximize whatever level of income they earn. The course will teach students to search and assess college and career opportunities, identify and prioritize their personal money management goals, develop personal spending and savings plans, comprehend the impact of time on the value of money, understand the cost of using credit, and protect their assets.

GLAAACC INTERNSHIPS & MENTORSHIPS

GLAAACC Ed Fund Internship Program connects college students with transformative professional experiences by partnering with companies to share internship opportunities and prepare scholars for the workforce. We provide tailored career readiness support—including mock interviews, resume workshops, and mentorship—to ensure students are equipped to excel in their roles.

Through collaborations with GLAAACC partner companies, students gain hands-on experience in dynamic work environments, working on projects that align with their skills and career goals. We actively guide scholars through the process, from opportunity discovery to professional growth, fostering a pipeline of emerging talent ready to make an impact. **One-on-One Mentors** have the unique role of working with youth to provide a solid support system and be a reliable trusted adult in the young person's life. Many of our youth have not had a solid foundation or positive role model in their lives. Our goal is to develop long lasting relationships between the mentors and the mentees. Individual goals are created to empower youth, and to master life skills that enhance his/her future success in college and job readiness.

For more than two decades GLAAACC Education Fund and Foundation has helped students achieve the dream of college. This program reflects the vision of the GLAAACC Chairman Gene hale and his generosity and leadership in Los Angeles. As GLAAACC Education Fund and Foundation looks ahead to its next century, we celebrate the important continuity this program brings to our community and culture, as well as our shared values of leadership, responsibility and service.
